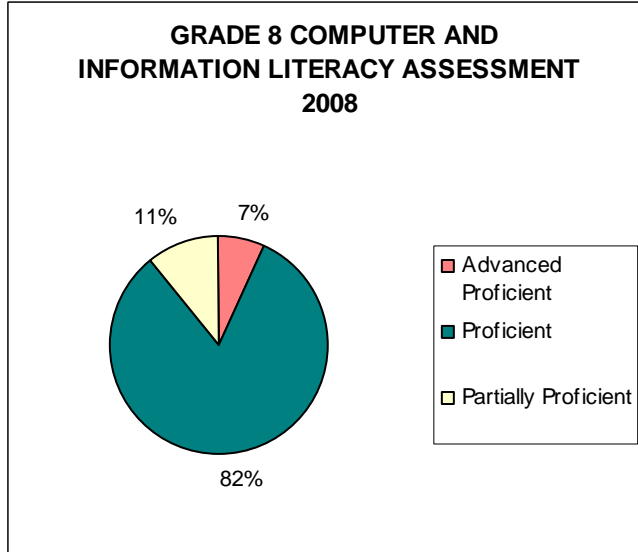


WNY STUDENTS PERFORM WELL IN COMPUTER AND LITERACY

For the first time in New Jersey, all fourth and eighth grade students were mandated to be tested in computer and information literacy. The eighth grade students had outstanding scores with 7% of the students having advanced proficiency and 82% of the students being proficient.

The students in our district were assessed in technology using the Computer and Information Literacy NJTAP-IN Rubric.



All students in Grade 4 were assessed in technology using a checklist to assure that each student was proficient according to the New Jersey Core Curriculum Standards for technology. This year 86% of our fourth graders were proficient in technology.
